First Piece of Evidence + Reasoning

 - Given evidence of many chromosomes
 - Nancy Normal had Triple X Syndrome
 - Crime Scene 2 had Triple X Syndrome

Sixth Piece of Evidence + Reasoning

- Tony, Nancy's father, had Huntington's Disease, and Nancy inherited it from him
 - Nancy Normal had Huntington's Disease, which results in problems with mood and mental abilities
 - More likely to murder someone

Motive + Evidence + Reasoning

- Thomas Sandstone murdered Nancy's cousin, killed her father and led her aunt to depression in a mental hospital
- Carleton Comet recently changed his name (from Thomas Sandstone), claims to have many children, and just got released from prison for murder
 - Thomas Sandstone is Carleton Comet

Charge

- Nancy Normal should be tried for first degree murder
 - She intentionally killed Carleton Comet
 - First Degree Murder: any intentional murder that is willful and premeditated with malice aforethought
